

SEANATHAIR ACCLAMATIONS


For assembly and keyboard/guitar with optional instruments and SAB choir

Seanathair Acclamations is designed to be flexible and can be sung with a simple piano or guitar accompaniment or with the addition of SAB (or descant) and between one and four melody instruments in almost any combination.

This is a simple setting with a gentle, almost Celtic, feel.

Seanathair is Celtic for "grandfather".
