



Performance Note: Summer Alleluia is sung three times.

1st time the assembly sings Alleluia.

2nd time choir or assembly hums the tune under cantor's verses (Harmony 1)

3rd time the assembly sings the Alleluia with choir on either or both harmonies with the words, Alleluia.
